The Highlands at Trexler Field, the first neighborhood under construction, features 242 twin villas ranging in size from 1900 to 2500 square feet, all with 2-car garages.

Exercise enthusiasts also can enjoy the 100-acre Bob Rodale Cycling Center and Fitness Park in Trexlertown, less than 2 miles away.
